

VIEW RIDGE COMMUNITY COUNCIL  
TRUSTEES MEETING  
MARCH 16, 2004

The meeting was called to order by president Michael Williams at 7:05 p.m.

Our guest speaker was Baser Belza. She is a board member of "Friends of Magnuson Park". She gave us an update of events leading up to the Public Hearing scheduled for Wednesday, April 21 at 6 p.m. **Everyone** is urged to attend.

The minutes of the February 17 meeting were read and approved.

The treasurer's report was given by Duane LaViolette. 340 households have contributed an average of \$13.59 each. We now have a balance of \$5433.65.

CORRESPONDENCE

- a. An informational packet was received dated March 11, '04 concerning Land Use notice for light poles at Magnuson Park.
- b. A letter was received from the Mayor's office about the 18th Annual Spring Clean Event. ~~It is~~ slated to be held March 27th to May 15th. Many ideas were discussed as to what we could do to clean up our neighborhood. Final decisions will be made in the April meeting.
- c. A flyer was received from Sound Transit announcing a public meeting with the contractor Wednesday, March 24, '04 at 8:30 a.m. at Starbucks Center, 2401 Utah Avenue South. This will be the first in a series of public meetings that Sound Transit will hold to explain the construction of Link light rail in SODO.
- d. A post card was received from the Seattle Community Council Federation announcing a meeting at the NOAA Lake Union Headquarters March 25 at 7:00 p.m. The topic will be rezoning all single family ~~units~~ to duplex status.
- e. Notes were received from a meeting with David Della concerning the proposed Magnuson Park master plan with special attention focused on the disagreements concerning this development.
- f. A copy of a letter sent to David Della from Vance Thompson was also received. It again stated the communities concern about the proposed development of the sports center at SPMP.
- g. A copy of a letter from Bob Rench to Eric Friedli was received by Michael Williams. This called attention to the fact that the proposed lighting of the sports field was in violation of its own lighting policy.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

- a. NEDC meeting notes were read by our president ~~due~~ to the absence of representative Bob. Highlights of the meeting included a discussion of

volunteer committces, UW Lease Lid violations, possible coverage of water reservoirs at Roosevelt and Maple Leaf, SPMP name change to MP, and the up and coming meeting with David Della concerning the park.

OLD BUSINESS

- a. A discussion of the Dick Phillips memorial took place and it was decided that a final decision would be made at the April meeting about this matter.
- b. The subdivision of the lot on 51st N.E. and 65th is still be<sup>ing</sup> contested. The hearing examiner ruled in favor of the developer. Further action is being discussed. The flavor of the community will be affected if housing is to be compacted. Joe Clark gave the report in the absence of Neale Weaver, it was his birthday.
